Hi John,

The work is a 13 week program which includes the set up and take down. The plan is to lay a temporary track along the northside of no 1 reservoir, erect some scaffolding around the survey site to allow us to do borehole surveys. During the project access will be restricted around the reservoir on the areas shown by yellow line on the drawing below. The water

level will be held at 3m down and refill of the reservoir post the survey will be determined once we have the survey results.

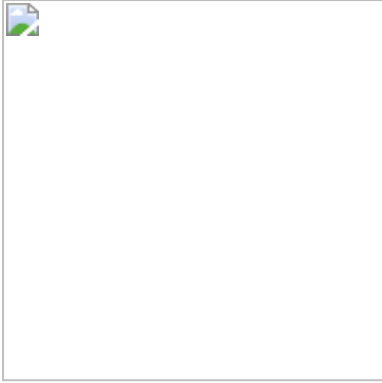
The project will come in by the main access road and use half the compound area/ car parking land for their site welfare and lay down area.
